- **New Business-**
 - **Newburg Picnic-**
 - From what we know it went well! Becca and Jane organized the set up and scheduling for the stand. We will have the total income at our next meeting.
 - **County Report-**
 - If we need any trail signs we can order them by July. As of right now we ordered more blazers and stop signs.
 - The state had 14 fatalities for the snowmobile season. Almost all were alcohol related.
 - To teach snowmobile safety you must be certified by the state and do either an in person class or watch two snowmobile safety classes being taught before you can be certified. Pat and Mike are up for recertification. The DNR is hosting a number of classes this summer. If you have an interest in becoming a certified teacher we can get you signed up for the classes. So far Pat has recertified and we have 4 members newly certified.
 - Last year there was a fatal crash via snowmobile and groomer. The club and groomer operator are at fault because of improper lighting on the groomer. The club's insurance now went up to \$49,000.
 - Any lumber costs need to be handed into billing and in turn we can get money back from the state.
 - They are already predicting the club checks will be late.
 - **Voting-**
 - Mike will stay as Vice President for the next term.
 - Craig (Harley) Davidson will be the new treasurer. We thank Clint Crass for his many years of service to the club!
 - For the board, we are going to drop one position and go back to the original 6 total board members that we started with.
